Updated Dominion photo simulations are on display at White Stone Town Hall

WHITE STONE—During a February 11 informational open house for its Rappahannock River transmission line rebuild and relocation project, Dominion Virginia Power reported it unintentionally printed and displayed photo simulations depicting an earlier version of the overhead transmission line design.

Dominion media relations representative Daisy Pridgen said the company apologizes for this mistake and regrets that the public was not able to view the most up-to-date information.

The company's currently proposed plan includes shorter structures than originally designed—however, the structure locations have not changed, according to a related post card sent to folks attending the recent open house.
