**D**ominion Power has proposed to replace the existing power cables that run alongside the Robert O. Norris Bridge across the Rappahannock River between Lancaster and Middlesex counties. The new steel and concrete towers will loom high above the bridge, introducing navigation hazards and a jarring intrusion into our scenic, open water.

**T**his "taking" of our scenic assets will have a direct impact on the economic strength of our communities. The natural beauty of our area is our calling card to boosters, visitors, and home buyers.

**T**he Lancaster and Middlesex County Boards of Supervisors, along with town councils in Kilmarnock, Irvington and Urbanna, oppose the project as do owners of fifty local businesses, in favor of placing the lines under the riverbed.
